Description: The proposed project involves moving a property line 16 feet to the north to enable the transfer of ownership and development of the residentially zoned lot. The project requires the following actions:

- General Plan Amendment GP-14-01. Change the land use designation of a 16-foot by 63-foot strip of land within an existing church site from Public Institutional (PI) to Medium Density Residential (MDR).
- 2. **Rezone R-14-01.** Rezone a 16-foot by 63-foot strip of land within an existing church site from I&R (Institutional and Recreational) to R2-MD (Multiple Family Residential Medium Density).
- Lot Line Adjustment LL-14-03. Adjustment of the rear property line of 320 18th Street 16 feet to the north, to acquire a 1,008-square foot portion of the property at 301 Magnolia Street. The portion of land is adjacent to the church parking lot.
