1. BILLING / ADVERTISING

Unless otherwise stated to the contrary in the Contract, Artist shall receive 100% sole headline billing in any and all press releases, advertisements and other publicity including, but not limited to, radio, television, ad mats, tickets, newspapers, programs, fliers, signs, lobby boards and marquees. Producer shall have approval over all advertising, promotions and sponsorship.

Producer shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel the Engagement without liability, by giving Purchaser notice thereof at least thirty (30) days prior to the start of the Engagement.

3. FORCE MAJEURE

If Artist's performance(s) hereunder is rendered impossible, hazardous or is otherwise prevented or impaired due to sickness, inability to perform, accident, interruption or failure of means of transportation, Act(s) of God, riots, strikes, labor difficulties, epidemics, earthquakes, any act or order of any public authority, and/or any other cause or event, similar or dissimilar, beyond Producer's control, then Producer's obligations with respect to the affected performance(s) shall be excused and Producer shall have no liability to Purchaser in connection therewith. Provided Artist is ready, willing and able to perform, Purchaser shall remain liable to pay Producer the full contract price plus any monies called for in the Contract regardless of the occurrence of any of the foregoing events. For purposes of this provision, the term "Artist" shall include, Artist or any member thereof.

4. INCLEMENT WEATHER

Producer's obligations hereunder shall be excused and Producer/Artist shall have no liability to Purchaser if Artist determines in good faith that their performance is (or is likely to be) rendered impossible, hazardous or is otherwise prevented or impaired due to inclement weather. In such event (and notwithstanding anything to the contrary), Purchaser shall remain liable to Producer for the full contract price plus any percentage monies called for in the Contract.

5. STAGING

Purchaser shall provide and pay for an adequate stage suitable for its intended purpose. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, said stage shall be designed and constructed in order to accommodate Artist's production requirements including those contained in the attached Artist Technical Rider. If the Engagement is to be performed outdoors, Purchaser shall provide and pay for adequate stage covering and grounding to protect all persons and equipment involved in the production of the Engagement (including Artist and their crew) from inclement weather and dangerous conditions resulting therefrom. The foregoing shall apply to, without limitation, all stage areas, mixing consoles and wiring. Producer shall have the sole right to determine in good faith whether such covering and grounding is adequate.

6. CREATIVE CONTROL

Producer shall have exclusive control over all creative elements of the Engagement including, without limitation, the creative elements of the following: sound, lights, choice of performers (including master of ceremonies and welcoming speakers) and their length of performance, stage sets, curtains, backdrops, song selection, manner of performance, and any music, film or videotape played to patrons at any time during the Engagement including prior to performance and during intermission (if any).

7. ANCILLARY RIGHTS

a. RECORDING

9. INDEMNIFICATION

Purchaser agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Producer and Artist and each of their respective employees, agents and contractors from and against any claims, costs (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs), expenses, damages, liabilities, losses and/or judgments arising out of, or in connection with, any claim, demand or action made by a third party if such are (or are alleged to be) a direct or indirect consequence of: (i) the Engagement or (ii) any breach or alleged breach of any warranty, representation, agreement or covenant made by Purchaser herein. This indemnity and hold harmless provision shall not apply to any claims, costs, expenses, damages, liabilities, losses, and/or judgments resulting from the gross negligence or willful misconduct of Producer and/or Artist and each of their respective employees, agents and contractors.

Purchaser shall pay, at its sole cost, all taxes, fees, dues, levies and the like relating to the Engagement and the sums payable to Producer shall be free of same. 11. CHOICE OF LAW AND FORUM

This Rider and Contract shall be deemed made and entered into in the State of California and shall be governed by the laws of such State applicable to contracts entered into and wholly to be performed therein. The State or Federal courts located in Orange County, California shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any disputes arising hereunder and the parties hereto agree to submit to the jurisdiction of these courts.

12. INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

Producer's failure to request, review or comment on such certificates shall not affect Producer's rights or Purchaser's obligations hereunder.

14. SECURITY

Purchaser is solely responsible for providing security in connection with the Engagement. Accordingly, Purchaser shall provide and pay for adequate security for the protection of all persons and property in connection with the Engagement including, without limitation, Producer, Artist (and each of their respective agents, employees, contractors and equipment) and patrons. The foregoing is in addition to any other security requirements of Producer contained in the attached Artist Production Rider (if any).

Purchaser shall secure, at its sole cost, all licenses, permits, certificates, leases, authorizations and the like required or requested by any union, guild, governmental authority, performing rights society, Venue owner or any other third party in connection with (i) the Engagement and (ii) Artist's / Producer's exercise of any rights granted herein. Purchaser agrees to fulfill, or cause to be fulfilled, all terms, conditions, covenants, rules and/or regulations of such parties in connection therewith as well as pay all levies, dues and fees applicable thereto. Upon request, Purchaser shall provide Producer with evidence of the foregoing; provided that Producer's failure to request or review same shall not be deemed a waiver of Purchaser's obligations or Producer's rights hereunder.

16. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS / PRODUCTION RIDER

Except as otherwise agreed to by the parties in writing or as otherwise stated in the attached Artist Production Rider (if any), Purchaser shall provide, at its sole cost, all elements of the production as required by Artist including, without limitation, catering, dressing rooms, internal ground transportation, sound, lights and backline equipment. If the Artist Production Rider is attached hereto, then said Artist Production Rider shall be made a part hereof and Purchaser agrees to fulfill or cause to be fulfilled, at its sole cost, all terms and conditions contained therein.

17. ADDITIONAL REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

Purchaser represents and warrants that: (i) it has the right and authority to enter into this Rider and Contract and to fully perform its obligations contained herein; (ii) it has the right to grant the rights granted herein and that Artist's / Producer's exercise of any such rights does not and will not infringe upon or impair the rights or interests of any third party; (iii) all goods, equipment and other materials provided by Purchaser (or at its request or direction) shall be safe, fully operational, and will not cause injury or damage to any person or property; and (iv) that all persons provided by Purchaser (including, its agents, employees and contractors) shall be adequately trained and capable of performing their required duties and that such persons shall, at all times, act in a safe manner, without causing injury or damage to any person or property. The undersigned warrant and represent that they are authorized to execute this Rider and Contract on behalf of the respective parties.

18. RETURN OF CONTRACT Purchaser agrees to sign and return this Rider and Contract to Producer's agent, APA Talent Agency, within ten (10) days from the date of the Contract; otherwise Producer shall have the right to cancel the Engagement upon notice thereof without liability. Producer's failure to exercise its right to cancel the Engagement upon the completion of said ten (10) day period shall not be deemed a waiver of Producer's right to cancel the Engagement at any time thereafter.

19. MODIFICATION / ASSIGNMENT / MISC.

This Rider and Contract is the sole and complete agreement between the parties with respect to the Engagement and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements regarding the subject matter hereof. This Rider and Contract (or any part thereof) may not be changed, modified or waived except by a signed, written agreement of the parties.



It is expressly agreed that APA Talent Agency has the right, on behalf of the Artist at anytime, to require payment in full prior to Artist's departure for engagement(s) mentioned on the face of this contract. The Purchaser's failure to comply with these provisions shall be considered willful breach of contract and all deposits in possession of APA Talent Agency and shall be retained on behalf of

All notices, consents, approvals and the like given in connection with this Rider and Contract shall not be effective unless contained in a writing, signed by the party giving same.

21. PARAGRAPH HEADINGS

Paragraph headings are used herein for convenience only and shall not be used to interpret this Rider.

WANDA JACKSON GENERAL RIDER

I. DRESSING ROOMS/HOSPITALITY

- A. Wanda Jackson shall have a separate private dressing room. It should be a secure area with easy access to stage. If dressing room is capable of being locked, a key will be given to tour manager at load-in and returned after load out.
- B. A second dressing room for the band should be large enough to accommodate comfortable seating for up to seven people and storage of personal items and instruments.
- C. The following shall be placed in the dressing/green room at load in.
- -4 clean, white terry cloth hand towels for stage
- -1 case (24) of bottled drinking water
- -1 case (24) of Premium Beer (iced down)
- 1 Bottle of Chardonnay
- 1 Bottle of Red Wine
- Light snacks for Artist and band

Wanda requires hot (drinkable temperature) Traditional Medicinals "Throat Coat" tea 15 minutes prior to her performance "Throat Coat" can be found at Walgreens or any other major drug, supermarket or health goods store.

II. DINNER ACCOMMODATIONS

- A. Up to seven (7) hot, healthy, appetizing meals shall be provided at a time agreed on between the tour manager and the venue.
- B. In the situation of a catered dinner tour manager must sign off menu in advance.
- C. Buy Out: Meal buy outs are \$20.00 per person. This is payable in cash to tour manager prior to load-in.

III. HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS

Artist shall receive 1 king suite & and up to 8 single or 4 double rooms. Lodging should be good quality, clean, and in a safe location with secured parking. Rooms shall be available for check in 6 hours prior to load-in. Preferred lodging: 1) Embassy Suites - 2) Hilton Suites - 3) Crowne Plaza or reputable chains like Marriott, Hilton, Hampton Inn, et al

IV. MERCHANDISING

The venue agrees to provide a table and chairs in a highly visible, well lit and secure area for the Artist to sell merchandise. Artist requires use of a phone line during event for credit/debit transactions. If one can't be provided during show have one available after show.



A. SOUND EQUIPMENT

PURCHASER shall provide a professional quality sound system adequate to cover venue and including at least:

- 1. A state-of-the-art professional quality sound mixing board, with a minimum of sixteen (16) channels and outputs for mains and monitors, four (4) bands of EQ per channel (3 bands EQ per channel with mid-sweep is acceptable), outputs for mains, monitors and at least one extra aux/effects send.
- 2. All mics on boom stands.
- 3. MINIMUM of FIVE (5) wedge floor monitors with MINIMUM of FOUR (4) mixes with a 1/3 octave EQ for each monitor mix. 15" monitors preferred (especially for drum position). If touring with more than five band members, monitors and mixes to increase.
- 4. The system should have 1/3 octave EQ on main send(s) and speakers of at least a 15" hom cabinet for mid/highs and a subwoofer for lows.
- 5. Power amplification of at MINIMUM 300 watts per side for mid/highs and 600 watts for the subwoofer.
- 6. The above system should cover a small auditorium or theater (500 seats). Size of main speakers and power amplification should be increased accordingly for larger facilities or outdoor festivals. (Stage diagram is attached.)
- 7. The mixing and sound board must be operated from an audience position. This position must have a full, clear view of stage
- 8. THE VENUE OR SOUND COMPANY SHALL PROVIDE AT LEAST ONE (1) AND NO MORE THAN TWO (2) QUALIFIED SOUND TECHNICIANS WHO SHALL BE THE SAME PERSONS AT THE SOUND CHECK AND ALL PERFORMANCES OF THIS ENGAGEMENT IN ORDER TO ASSIST ARTIST AND/OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE.
- 9. If there is an opening band the venue must guard or re-patch all of the vocal and acoustic channels of ARTIST and return all other channels to their post ARTIST sound check positions.
- 10. Please provide name and day of show phone number/email of house sound engineer.

B. LIGHTS

- 1. PURCHASER shall provide a professional quality lighting system for any indoor performance and/or any outdoor performance when performance will take place near or after sunset.
- 2. Lighting should be a minimum of a general stage wash covering the entire area designated on the stage diagram. In all possible instances, a solo spotlight and operator shall be provided.

C. BACKLINE

- 1. In the event PURCHASER is to provide and pay for ARTIST backline, instrument requirements are listed below (a detailed list with a stage plot is attached to the end of this rider):
- -3 homs with Dis
- -1 electric bass and bass rig
- -2 guitars with amps
- -1 pedal steel with amp
- -1 organ/keys with amp or DIs
- -1 drum kit

D. LOADERS

1. VENUE to provide a minimum of two (2) sober loaders/stagehands for Load In and Load out. This is non-negotiable.
