NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on November 3, 2015 the City Council introduced proposed Ordinance No. 15-15:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COSTA MESA, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING ZONING CODE AMENDMENT CO-14-02 TO AMEND COSTA MESA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 13 FOR A SITE-SPECIFIC DENSITY OF 54 DWELLING UNITS PER ACRE AND SITE-SPECIFIC BUILDING HEIGHT AT 2277 HARBOR BOULEVARD IN THE PDR-HD ZONE

Proposed Ordinance No. 15-15 amends Costa Mesa Municipal Code Title 13 to make specific references to the parcel, where appropriate, including the site-specific height and density for the development site in the PDR-HD zone and any other related changes. The proposed 224-unit project would require an amendment to Table 13-58 (Planned Development Standards) to allow a site-specific density of 54 dwelling units per acre for this project.
