Ordinance No. 16-04 adopts Code Amendment CO-16-01 to amend Title 13 (Zoning Code), Chapter VIII, Signs, of the Costa Mesa Municipal Code. The Code amendment involves amending regulations applicable to temporary portable signs which are not permanently affixed to the ground or a structure(s). The scope of the proposed changes is limited to the physical regulation of temporary portable signs. Environmental Determination: Exempt.
