Description: A conditional use permit for a microbrewery with a tasting room and outdoor patio area (Salty Bear). The microbrewery proposes to occupy a 3,192-square-foot lease area at 2948 Randolph Avenue. The proposed business involves:

- Alcohol sales for onsite and offsite consumption
- The microbrewery will not sell food
- The proposed hours of operation are: 4 a.m. to 4 p.m. for production and 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight for the tasting room
- Pedestrian access from Randolph Avenue and pedestrian access from The Camp (2937 Bristol St.)
- Deviation from parking requirements due to unusual operation characteristics. Multiple tenant's spaces at 2944 and one tenant space at 2948 shall remain unoccupied for site to meet its parking requirements.

The site address is 2944-2948 Randolph Avenue; MG Zone. The applicant/Agent is Phillip Schwartze.

Environmental Determination: The project is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301 (Class 1), Existing Facilities.
