# AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES INC.

This Amendment Number One ("Amendment") is made and entered into this 22nd day of January, 2018 ("Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF COSTA MESA, a municipal corporation ("City"), and STANTEC CONSULTING SERVICES INC., a New York corporation registered to do business in California ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, City and Consultant entered into an agreement on June 1, 2017 for Consultant to update the City's Bicycle Master Plan (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant desire to amend the Scope of Services to include the additional services set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, City desires to increase Consultant's maximum compensation accordingly to Forty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Four Dollars (\$43,504.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Scope of Services shall be amended to include the additional services set forth in Exhibit A.
- 2. Section 2.1 of the Agreement shall be amended to reflect that Consultant's total compensation shall not exceed Forty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Four Dollars (\$43,504.00). Consultant shall be paid according to the fee schedule set forth in the Agreement and Exhibit A of this Amendment.
- 3. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement.
- 4. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) is pleased to present this proposal to prepare an Addendum to the certified Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the City of Costa Mesa 2015-2035 General Plan dated June 26, 2016 (State Clearinghouse 2015111053) to address California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements for adopting the Active Transportation Plan (ATP). Our understanding of the project, proposed scope of work, schedule, opinion of probable cost, and assumptions/exclusions are below.

#### **Project Understanding**

Stantec understands that the EIR certified for the City of Costa Mesa 2015-2035 General Plan in 2016 included a Conceptual Bicycle Master Plan. Since that time, an ATP has been prepared and the City of Costa Mesa proposes to adopt it and incorporate it into the Circulation Element of the 2015-2035 General Plan.

The ATP includes the following changes to the Conceptual Master Blcycle Plan.

- Conceptual Bioycle Master Plan Map and List of Changes minor changes to the map and list shown in the Attachment.
- The following "Recommendations" in the Conceptual Bioycle Master Plan in the Adopted General Plan have been changed to "Policies" in the proposed ATP:
  - C-7.1, C-7.2, C-7.4, C-7.5, C-7.6, C-7.10, C-7.13, C-7.20, C-7.33, C-8.3, C-8.4, C-8.5, C-8.9, C-8.16, C-8.20, C-8.22, C-9.1, C-9.2, C-9.3, C-9.5, C-9.10, C-10.1, C-10.8, C-10.2, C-10.3, C-11.4, C-11.7, C-11.9, C-12.1 and C-12.2 combined to form one policy, C-12.3, and C-12.6.
- Recommendations Removed:
  - C-7.7, C-7.8
- New Recommendation Added;
  - Recommendation 6 in Goal 3 of ATP

#### Scope of Work

Stantec proposes to prepare an Addendum to the certified Final EIR for the City of Costa Mesa 2015-2035 General Plan to address CEQA requirements for adopting the ATP. An addendum is a short document containing information supplementing an earlier environmental document (in this case, the certified Final EIR). An addendum may be used to describe any minor, technical revisions or changes to the project or the environment in which it will be implemented, for purposes of establishing that no further environmental review is required pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15162. The addendum is not the environmental document for the project. It is merely a supplement to the earlier environmental document. The Findings for adopting the ATP would be based on the 2015-2035 General Plan EIR, as supplemented by the Addendum.

The Addendum will be prepared to meet the requirements of Section 15164 of the CEQA Guidelines which requires a brief explanation of the decision not to prepare a subsequent EIR pursuant to Section 15162 of the CEQA Guidelines that is supported by substantial evidence.

Stantec will prepare an Addendum that includes the following or similar components to meet the above requirement:

- Introduction
- Project Description
- Comparative Evaluation of Environmental Impacts
- Determination

Stantec's proposed scope of work includes preparation of a Draft Addendum and a Final Addendum that addresses City of Costa Mesa comments on the Draft.

#### Schedule

Stantec proposes to prepare a Draft Addendum within two weeks of receiving a mutually executed written agreement to proceed and a Final Addendum within one week of receiving comments by the City on the Draft Addendum.

#### Opinion of Probable Cost

Stantec proposes to complete the above described scope of work on a time and materials basis for a not to exceed without prior written approval

  the proposed changes since the 2015-2035 General Plan EIR
  was certified.
- Assumes one round of comments from the City on the Draft Addendum.
- Stanted's scope of work does not include technical studies, performance of field surveys/assessments, attendance at meetings, public noticing, or payment of any required processing fees.


