Your Next Steps:

- Fill out a Volunteer Application which is available at the Senior Center or online at: www.costamesaca.gov/seniorcenter (Click on the "Volunteer Program & Application" box).
- Mail-in or drop off your volunteer application at the Senior Center. The Recreation Specialist will review your application and contact you to set up an interview, and then follow-up with you regarding your volunteer status.
- Once the right volunteer opportunity is found, the Recreation Specialist will contact you to schedule an appointment for a Live Scan*.
- After the Recreation Specialist receives your cleared Live Scan results, you will be contacted to discuss your volunteer assignment.
- * Live Scan is a process that takes your fingerprints and submits them to the Department of Justice where they run a background check. This is required for all volunteers as you will interact with patrons as a City Representative and may be exposed to sensitive information.

 This process is mandatory in order to become a volunteer.
