## AMENDMENT NUMBER SIX TO MAINTENANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CLEANSTREET

This Amendment Number Six ("Amendment") is made and entered into this 20th day of October, 2020 ("Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF COSTA MESA, a municipal corporation ("City"), and CLEANSTREET, a California corporation ("Contractor").

WHEREAS, City and Contractor entered into an agreement on October 24, 2016 for Contractor to provide pressure washing and sweeping and debris removal services (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of the Agreement provides for a term of one (1) year, with the option to extend the Agreement for three (3) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2017, City and Contractor exercised the first option to extend the Agreement and extended the term for one (1) year, through October 23, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2018, City and Contractor amended the Scope of Services and increased Contractor's maximum annual compensation accordingly; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2018, City and Contractor exercised the second option to extend the Agreement and extended the term for one (1) year, through October 23, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2019, City and Contractor exercised the third option to extend the Agreement, extending the term for one (1) year, through October 23, 2020, amended the Scope of Services, and increased Contractor's maximum annual compensation; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor now desire to extend the term of the Agreement for one (1) additional year, through October 23, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The term of the Agreement shall be extended through October 23, 2021.
- 2. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement.
- 3. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement not in conflict with this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. All counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one agreement. Counterpart written signatures may be transmitted by facsimile, email or other electronic means and have the same legal effect as if they were original signatures.
