AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BUXTON COMPANY

This Amendment Number One ("Amendment") is made and entered into as of April 2, 2021 ("Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF COSTA MESA, a municipal corporation ("City"), and BUXTON COMPANY, a Texas corporation ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, City and Consultant entered into an agreement on April 3, 2020 for Consultant to provide retail recruitment and mobile visitor insights solution services (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, concurrently with entering into the Agreement, City and Consultant entered into Addendum Number One to the Agreement ("Addendum One") in order to provide the City with access to LSMx software subscriptions during the term of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement and Addendum One are collectively referred to herein as the "Agreement"; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of the Agreement provides for a term of one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant desire to amend Section 4.1 of the Agreement to include the option for City and Consultant to extend the term for four (4) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant desire to extend the term for one (1) year, through April 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant desire to amend the Scope of Services to include the additional services set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant desire to set forth Consultant's compensation for such additional services accordingly; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant intend and desire that this Amendment be effective retroactive to the Effective Date.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. This Amendment shall be effective retroactive to the Effective Date.
- 2. Section 4.1 of the Agreement shall be amended to read as follows:
 - 4.1. <u>Term.</u> This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue for a period of one (1) year, ending on April 2, 2021, unless previously terminated as provided herein or as otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties. This Agreement may be extended by four (4) additional one (1) year periods upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

- 3. The term of the Agreement shall be extended through April 2, 2022.
- 4. The Scope of Services shall be amended to include the additional services set forth in Exhibit A.
- 5. Section 2.1 of the Agreement shall be amended to reflect that Consultant's annual compensation shall not exceed Twenty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$24,950.00). Consultant shall be paid according to the fee schedule set forth in Exhibit A of this Amendment.
- 6. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement.
- 7. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 8. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. All counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one agreement. Counterpart written signatures may be transmitted by facsimile, email or other electronic means and have the same legal effect as if they were original signatures.
