## AMENDMENT NUMBER FOUR TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH SAFEBUILT, LLC

This Amendment Number Four ("Amendment") is made and entered into as of the 30th day of June, 2021 ("Effective Date"), by and between the CITY OF COSTA MESA, a municipal corporation ("City"), and SAFEBUILT, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company registered to do business in California ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, City and Consultant entered into an agreement on October 1, 2017 for Consultant to provide inspection services on an as-needed basis (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of the Agreement provides for a term of one (1) year, with the option to extend the Agreement for four (4) additional one (1) year periods; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2018, City and Consultant extended the term through September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2019, City and Consultant extended the term though September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2020, City and Consultant extended the term through June 30, 2021 and provided the option for an additional one (1) year extension; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant now desire to extend the term for one (1) additional year, through June 30, 2022, and to amend the fee schedule set forth in Section 2.1 of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant intend and desire that this Amendment be effective retroactive to the Effective Date.

NOW, THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. This Amendment shall be effective retroactive to the Effective Date.
- 2. The term of the Agreement shall be extended through June 30, 2022.
- Section 2.1 of the Agreement shall be amended to reflect that Consultant shall be paid in accordance with the amended fee schedule set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein, commencing July 1, 2021.
- 4. All terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning and use as set forth in the Agreement.
- 5. All other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

6. This Amendment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. All counterparts shall be construed together and shall constitute one agreement.
