2. Historical Site Markers Phase II

- Lisa showed the Committee the marker and will let the Committee know when the City Engineer places the mark into the sidewalk. Lisa will email Margy's verbiage for the Committee to review.
- Margy found the following information about Bayview Ice Company (1704 Flower between the years 1936-1946) was owned and operated by the Dinger family. The ice was made in Newport Beach and brought to the Costa Mesa location where it was stored. The ice was made in 300 lb blocks and sold in 100 lb pieces for 25 cent per 100 lbs. Delivered daily to homes and businesses

including the Santa Ana Army Air Force Base during WWII. The Dingers let customers use the ice lockers to store large amounts of meat (beef, pork or goat) and storage fee were often paid with pieces of frozen meat.
